ACME SIDE-WINDER® SPOON IDEAL FOR FALL/WINTER VERTICAL JIGGING TECHNIQUES

Fast-Sinking Lure Tempts Trophy Gamefish With Flash, Action and Realism

Acme's Side-Winder® spoon has long been known as a deadly lure for targeting gamefish all year long, in all portions of the water column. It's a secret weapon of top spin fishermen and trollers targeting everything from trout and bass to salmon and stripers.

This lure's fast-sinking properties and unique, non-symmetrical body shape make the Acme Side-Winder a solid choice for vertical fishing techniques. For example, as lakes cool in the fall and winter months, largemouth bass tend to suspend in the water column where forage and comfortable water temperatures combine. In addition, their slower metabolic rate makes them less likely to expend energy chasing down prey. At times like these, locating fish and/or schools of bait on your sounder and vertically jigging with metal spoons can be highly effective.

Acme's Side-Winder spoon is perfect for this technique. Its flat, thick body helps the Acme Side-Winder sink to a given depth quickly, while the unique shape provides erratic, "wounded baitfish" movement when jigged or retrieved towards the surface. The repeated "in your face" action of an Acme Side-Winder worked vertically near prowling fish is often more than predators can stand. The attraction of Acme's Side-Winder's action is further enhanced by the spoon's deep-cut gills, scales, eyes and fins, which add to the lure's realism and increase the reflection of underwater light in all directions.

Fishing Acme Side-Winder straight up and down will fool more than trophy bass. This same technique is effective on all fish holding deep in the water column, hanging near deep structure or hunting schools of suspended baitfish. Trout, landlocked stripers, pike and more can find Acme Side-Winder's combination of action and flash too much to resist. These same qualities also make Side-Winder an excellent choice when fishing through the ice, bringing large trout, pickerel, pike and walleye up for dinner.

To cover a wide range of fish and fishing applications, Acme offers the Side-Winder in 1/8-oz., 1/5-oz. and 1/3-oz. sizes, as well as 1/2-oz. and 3/4-oz. sizes based on the same body profile. All are available in Gold, Nickel, Nickel/Chartreuse Stripe and Gold/Florescent Stripe. Like all Acme spoons, the Side-Winder is built to last, with jewel-quality plating, stainless steel split rings and super sharp treble hooks that keep fish on the line.
