One important key to K.O. Wobbler's unique success is its wide, relatively short body design. This shape gives the Acme K.O. Wobbler the profile of a full-bodied baitfish as it moves through the water, providing large predators with the illusion of a satisfying meal. This shape also imparts the Acme K.O. Wobbler with a "fat," exaggerated wobble on the retrieve or troll, attracting gamefish with its enticing action. And with a choice of 12 jewel quality plated or painted finishes, fishermen can find an Acme K.O. Wobbler to match a wide variety of local forage, water conditions and fishing situations.

Another unique feature found on the K.O. Wobbler is Acme's Sonic Flipper Tail. It's well known that gamefish use sound to help hone in on prey, especially in stained or clouded water. As the Acme K.O. Wobbler moves through the water, its metallic tail provides added flash, while it simultaneously creates "clicking" noises as it strikes the body and hook shank. This added sensory trigger is often all that's needed to turn a follow into a powerful strike.

This versatile spoon can be fished in a variety of ways. Anglers can work it through deep holes where big steelhead hang, cast to trophy pike along weed lines or troll it deep for salmon in freshwater or salt. However they fish it, anglers can trust this lure's premium quality components, like stainless steel split rings and needle-sharp treble hooks that hook and hold gamefish during the toughest fights.
