ROGUE RIDGE™ CLIMBS TO THE TOP WITH THE RIDGE WARRIOR RB1000 E-BIKE

Take on Any Terrain, From Pavement to Rocks, Sand, Mud and Snow, with the Most Advanced Off-Road Electric Bike on the Market

Belgrade, MT — Years of packing out game from the deep backcountry lead to the emergence of Rogue Ridge, a company with deep knowledge of what hunters and outdoor enthusiasts truly need in an off-road electric bike. The flagship is the new Rogue Ridge RB1000, the ultimate transportation for those hard to reach places.

“Electric mountain bikes have grown tremendously for use in places where gas-powered machines have limited access,” said Mark Garcia, Rogue Ridge founder. “My partner Rock Bordelon and I spent two years developing the Ridge Warrior RB1000 design and we are confident that it is the ultimate back country e-bike. There is no other fat-tire e-bike on the market that has the durability, power, quality and features we do. We went with the best components we could find and worked hard to deliver the best-built bike for the demanding hunter.”

The **Ridge Warrior RB1000** was designed from the ground up to be a true backcountry hunter’s machine, starting with the Gates Carbon Belt Drive System. This system is basically a 1,000-watt motor system combined with a Panasonic 48V13AH Lithium Ion battery. It uses a carbon-fiber belt that lasts for over 10,000 miles of use and eliminates a derailleur, making tuning and maintaining the bike easier. The frame is hand-welded 6061 aluminum alloy, and the bike weighs in at 69 pounds. Perhaps most notable is the bike’s ability to hold up to 300 pounds of rider and gear. This is a key, as other e-bikes are not designed for heavier weights often associated with hunting. They can handle the hunter and some light gear, but what if the hunt is successful? The Rogue Ridge bikes are built to handle the extra load.

And what true backcountry e-bike would the Ridge Warrior RB 1000 be without real performance? The RB1000 has an average range of 29 miles without pedaling, and 50-60 miles in Pedal-Assist Mode. It has a top speed of 30 miles per hour. It has a full-color digital display that shows speed, avg. speed, trip distance, remaining battery power. The Juggernaut tires are tubeless, but Rogue Ridge includes tubes in the tires to add an additional layer of durability. The Ridge Warrior bikes include mudguards and a 50-lumen, hand-activated headlight. Additional features include:

Fork: Mozo, dropout 135mm Hydraulic shocks

Drive: Gates inner 3-speed system

Throttle: Thumb throttle

Brakes: Hydraulic Tektro-E715 downhill disc brakes.

Chain/Belts: Gates-NMN

Tires: Juggernaut 26" x 4.0" tubeless

Stem: Promax MA-400
