Featuring a 9.2" cutting surface with a robust 0.25" blade thickness, the full tang Bushcraft Woodsman is just shy of 15" and is made from 5160 steel with a hardness rating of 53-55 HRC.

"When you hold this knife in your hand you can really feel the blade-forward balance," said Deneb Pirrone, Ontario Knife Company's Director of Global Marketing and Sales. "It is built to chop and baton."

The OKC Bushcraft Woodsman is designed with a bird's head style grip with a large hilt under the blade. The ergonomic American Walnut handle is secured to the blade with blackened fasteners and features a lanyard hole in the pommel for the included paracord lanyard. This is a very comfortable handle that will keep your hand from slipping during hard use. The blade has a high off-center point with a flat-ground edge and a long cutting surface. Designed as a bushcraft and survival system, the knife comes with a fire-starter and striker, over 20 feet of paracord, and a durable nylon sheath by renowned holster manufacturer DeSantis[®].
